From the Preacherman....

Holy Week is curiosity.... What actually happened? Why? Why does Jesus go to Jerusalem when it is the place of conflict and destruction? Does he know he is going to die? Does it matter? When do his disciples know that he is going to die? And do they ever believe in resurrection? Do they ever act with faith or is it enough that they act just to save their own skin? Can you go with Jesus all the way to the Last Supper? To the Garden of Gethsemane? To his trial? To his crucifixion? To his death? Were you there when they crucified my Lord?

Holy Week is fear and trembling....When all else fails, just close the door and lock it, pull the shades and turn out the lights. Let the world solve its own problems. Don't you have enough on your own plate? And yet, lying down in the dark of night doesn't answer all of the questions, doesn't fill all the empty holes that are left gnawing away at the spaces. So you get up and walk the floor, staring out the window at 3 a.m. to see if there are any answers, any at all. Fear and trembling are part of Holy Week, just like curiosity. All of Jesus' followers, every single one of them, thought him dead, dead, dead. Graveyard dead. We may learn from life that the answer to that is public nobility, but this story forces us to embrace fear and trembling as part of the answer. Ignore this story if you must. Just don't ignore the reality.

Holy Week is silence.... Before we can do anything else, we must listen to the story. Just listen. That is it. We have to see it unfold, twist and turn, and come to a conclusion before our eyes, before we are even born. Wait and watch and see how Jesus lived, died and was buried. Read it in one of the Gospels or all of them. Pay attention to the story and what comes before the story and the silence behind the story. Whatever else you do, let the story happen to you this week. In silence.

Holy Week is hope.... After the curiosity, after the fear and trembling, after the silence, deep down, deeper than anything else in all the world, there is hope. I don't know how or when it got there. But there it is. It gets us up out of bed really early or very late, and when all else fails, we trust God. After all the followers fell away, after the disciples went into hiding, after the last family member said the last words of goodbye and went home and the tomb was sealed, then God acted. God raised Jesus from the dead and the world shifted on its axis and everything changed.

Wait and watch and see this week. There is hope. Just wait for it.
