## **Greetings from the Pastor,**

A number of years ago, a good friend of ours, Dr. Jan Linn, wrote a wonderful book based on Reinhold Niebuhr's prayer, traditionally called "The Serenity Prayer". In Jan's book, <u>Living Inside Out</u>, he points out that most of us actually live the opposite of what the prayer asks. He says we live as if we try to accept the things we can change, want courage to change the things we can't, and want the power to bring about the difference.

It's difficult to deal with situations in which we don't or can't get the outcome we wish; it's difficult to be the agent of change in situations we don't like; and often wisdom feels like not getting our own way. But Reverend Niebuhr's prayer is a powerful one; I pray it daily. I enclose it here, in its entirety. Read it carefully.

God grant me the serenity
To accept the things I cannot change;
Courage to change the things I can;
And wisdom to know the difference.
Living one day at a time;
Enjoying one moment at a time;
Accepting hardships as the pathway to peace;
Taking, as He did, this sinful world
As it is, not as I would have it;
Trusting that He will make all things right
If I surrender to His Will;
So that I may be reasonably happy in this life
And supremely happy with Him
Forever and ever in the next.
Amen.
