From the Preacherman....

What have you missed? That may be a question with too wide an aim. What have you missed during the pandemic, while we wore masks, worshiped online, met online, did seemingly everything through phones and computers? What things have you missed while we were apart? I actually missed waiting on food in a restaurant. I missed recognizing people in the grocery store. I missed going to ballgames.

I realized last Sunday just how much I had missed seeing your faces during worship. That sounds so simple, even simplistic, but is deeply true to me. Much is hidden by masks: smiles, frowns, yawns, interest. I missed terribly your faces in worship because I read faces when I preach. You can feign attention and hide boredom, you can laugh or cry with the crowd. But faces have always been the braille I read with my eyes when I preach. It has been impossible to do that when you attended on camera or behind a mask. I did not completely understand that until last Sunday. Your faces in person overwhelmed me. You were all talking to me at once!

Which has caused me to think more deeply about what comes next, the importance of our relationships, conversations and meetings. Ok, a confession. I didn't miss meetings. Did any of you really miss meetings? Yes, I thought so. I missed seeing you though, missed the three-minute chats and half hour conversations, missed them terribly because it is often the casual, throw away moments that bear the deepest truth and holiness in hindsight. Moses didn't go looking for the burning bush, but he noticed it. The presence of God is burning brightly everywhere. Do we notice?

I realize the irony in what I write. I will not see many of you in person any time soon. You are people I have known a long time and some I have never met. Yet, somehow, personally or from a distance, our shared interest in seeing and experiencing our faith brings us together, if only for a moment. In you, whether online or in person, I see the face of the risen One, the One who looks at me with deep affection, with grief and with great joy, with the fire of anger and the brilliance of divine presence, with kindness and gentleness and compassion. I see that when I see you. I am grateful to see that again.
