From the Preacherman....

Does church membership still matter? Some may be shocked that the question is even being asked, but in conversations with other pastors, in ministerial publications and in anxious discussions among church leaders the question is in the air. Ministers agree that the importance of membership has changed. Many people attend more than one church every week, something unheard of just a few decades ago. Membership in civic and recreational organizations is different, too. The Professional Bowling Association recently cancelled one of its premier events due to lack of interest among sponsors. Golf clubs, country clubs, veterans groups and fraternal organizations struggle to find new members. It isn't just the church, it's the whole country.

I'm not here to debate the reasons, but to embrace the new reality. I tell people that if I see them at church more than three times, I claim them as sheep of my fold. I subscribe to the belief that a pastor serves not only a congregation, but also a community. Thus, Owensboro, Daviess County and beyond are my parish, the geographical territory where God has called me to stand and proclaim the gospel. If someone calls me at 3 a.m., I don't check the church membership roll to determine my response. I answer, whether you are a member or not.

And yet, I believe being a member of a church still matters. Making a commitment to belong, support and sustain a congregation is a demanding thing, but such commitments define us for the better. Promises create habits and habits produce excellence. Call me crazy, but I believe belonging to a church can produce excellence. Membership means accepting the good with the bad, because there is no perfect church. Like every person, each church has strengths and weaknesses, faults and advantages. Every church is a mess, but so are our lives. God accepts us and loves us anyway. And makes us better. Together.

This is not a plea to join, but an invitation to discipleship. Commit to serving Christ in this church, or in some church, accepting the good with the bad, the easy with the difficult. Commit, otherwise you are just dating until you find something better. We need you and you need us. I believe it matters. Do you?


