May God bless you with Anger at Injustice, Oppression, and the Exploitation of People, so that you may work for Justice, Freedom, and Peace.

May God bless you with Tears to shed for those who suffer Pain, Rejection, Starvation, and War, so that You may reach out Your Hand out to Comfort them and turn their Sorrow into Joy.

And may God bless you with enough Foolishness to Believe that You can Make a Difference in this World, and DO those things others say cannot be Done.

Doesn't that just melt your soul? I am eternally grateful to St. Francis or whomever penned the profound mystery of this prayer. Just when I think I have it figured out, or settled down, another aspect rises up to greet me and arouse my faith. Do we really need more discomfort, anger, tears or foolishness? Isn't the world filled to overflowing with such struggles? Yes, until you let the prayer speak, truly speak, and the universe is opened to explore in wonder.
