y Thursday is observed during Holy Week on the ay before Easter. It commemorates the Last Supper when nared the Passover meal with his disciples on the night he was crucified. In contrast to joyful Easter celebrations ve celebrate the risen Savior, Maundy Thursday services ically more solemn occasions, marked by the shadow of etrayal.

different denominations observe Maundy Thursday in wn distinct ways, two important biblical events are the focus of Maundy Thursday solemnizations:

the Passover meal, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. forming this lowly act of service, the Bible says in John at Jesus "showed them the full extent of his love." By his e, Jesus demonstrated how Christians are to love one through humble service. For this reason, many churches foot-washing ceremonies as a part of their Maundy ay services.

the Passover meal, Jesus took bread and wine and asked her to bless it. He broke the bread into pieces, giving it to iples and said, "This is my body, given for you. Do this in brance of me." Then he took the cup of wine, shared it disciples and said, "This wine is the token of God's new nt to save you--an agreement sealed with the blood I will ut for you." For this reason, many churches hold special union services as a part of their Maundy Thursday tions.

oes "Maundy" Mean?

from the Latin word mandatum, meaning andment," Maundy refers to the commands Jesus gave iples at the Last Supper: to love with humility by serving other and to remember his sacrifice.
